Using a standard size trash bag with our cans is actualy pretty easy. The first time, it may seem abit of a process and we are working on improving this to make it easier. However once you do it once, you will see it is really about grabbing excess bag into a small tail, tucking the tail under the the rest of the bag, and putting the bucket back into the can.



step 1: When using a standard tall kitchen bag, you will notice a lot of bag overhang over the rim of the bucket.



step 4: Tuck the tail under the rest of the bag.



Gather the extra bag so it is tight around he rim of the bucket and all of the excess is bunched together in one spot.



step 5: Insert the bucket into the trash can



step 6: No ugly bag overhang.---



step 3: Twist the excess bag until it is in a small tail.
